I walked the lady back to the clothing room and asked Flora if she had a bag. A huge grin appeared on her face as she told us that one had been discovered just 5 minutes before. Praise God! He answers our prayer before we even ask.

Today, I had another awesome experience serving the Lord at Operation Blessing.

I met a man, Christopher, in the waiting room, and I invited him back to my desk. We chatted as we walked. I thought to myself, "What a pleasant young man, with such a sweet spirit." I opened his folder and noticed that this was his first visit, so I started to tell him about our services.

Christopher stopped me and said that he wanted to tell me how he came to need our help. I told him he didn't have to do so because God knew his heart. Also, I didn't want to embarrass him.

This is what he told me: He was a young hot-headed black man in his early 20's during the first part of the 1970's. He made a stupid, one-time mistake and received a life sentence from the courts. In prison, he met the Lord and learned to forgive the courts and the people who testified against him. He spent 38 1/2 years in prison, but he hopes to make Cleburne his home.

In my opinion, Christopher's life sentence was much too long for his crime. His final justice came from the Lord.
